Edmund LI R.G.D. and Reich+Petch Design International launch the "Favourite Things" exhibit at the Markham Museum

The "Favorite Things" exhibit designed by Edmund LI R.G.D. and the [Reich+Petch Design International](#) team is the first exhibition held at the [Markham Museum's](#) newly established Collections Building.

Markham's community members including donors, city councilors and student curators came together to share their favourite things from the town's most fragile collection of archives and textile artifacts that are housed in this new gallery space.

"As a resident of Markham, I feel strongly connected to the project and am proud to be contributing to my community as a designer. I hope our design reflects the museum's eclectic collection and Markham's rich heritage in a fun and refreshing way," said Edmund LI R.G.D. and Art Director.

Edmund, along with Vivien Chow, Graphic Designer, Ron Flood, Exhibit Designer, and Tony Reich, Principal-in-charge created a flow with the names of the museum's 75000+ individual objects and archival documents which form a typographic texture that weaves through the exhibit.

"The pattern of words is applied to graphic panels and labels as a decorative element, uniting the range of artifacts and exhibit elements through a unified visual language," said Edmund.

This exhibit launched on September 24, 2011 and will remain open to the public for six months.
