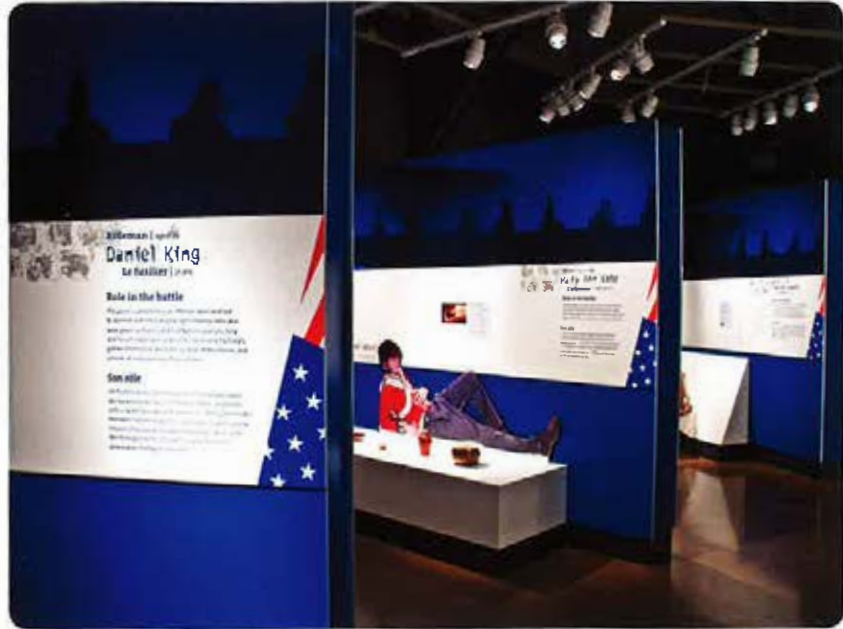

This historical attraction at Old Fort Erie sets the stage for visitors looking to learn more about the British siege of the American-held fort in 1814. The Fort's history is presented as a timeline. The exhibit space is divided equally into British and American territories, easily distinguished by the use of bright blue and red, which present the perspectives of the soldiers on both sides. The visitor experience is dynamic, with life-sized figures, showcased artifacts, replicas and a variety of audio-visual interactive elements. Playful details, such as the sounds of musket and cannon fire, engage visitors as they navigate the space.
